## CBSE SANKALP SAHODAYA HOSTS INSPIRING TLM EXHIBITION AT DISTRICT LEVEL DLD

As part of the two-day District Level DLD, the Innovate to Educate – TLM Exhibition organized by CBSE Sankalp Sahodaya brought together educators from across Delhi East district in a dynamic celebration of experiential learning.



Held on July 25th and 26th, the exhibition featured over 75 creative and skill-based Teaching-Learning Materials (TLMs) spanning various subjects. These innovative tools, aligned with the vision of NEP 2020 and CBSE’s focus on hands-on pedagogy, reflected deep curricular understanding, interdisciplinary integration, and inclusivity.

DIS Edge’s standout contribution—a textbook-free foundational learning module—captured attention for its fresh approach to early education, prioritizing real-world learning and child-led exploration.

This cultural exchange initiative reflects the school's ongoing dedication to developing global citizens prepared for an interconnected world.

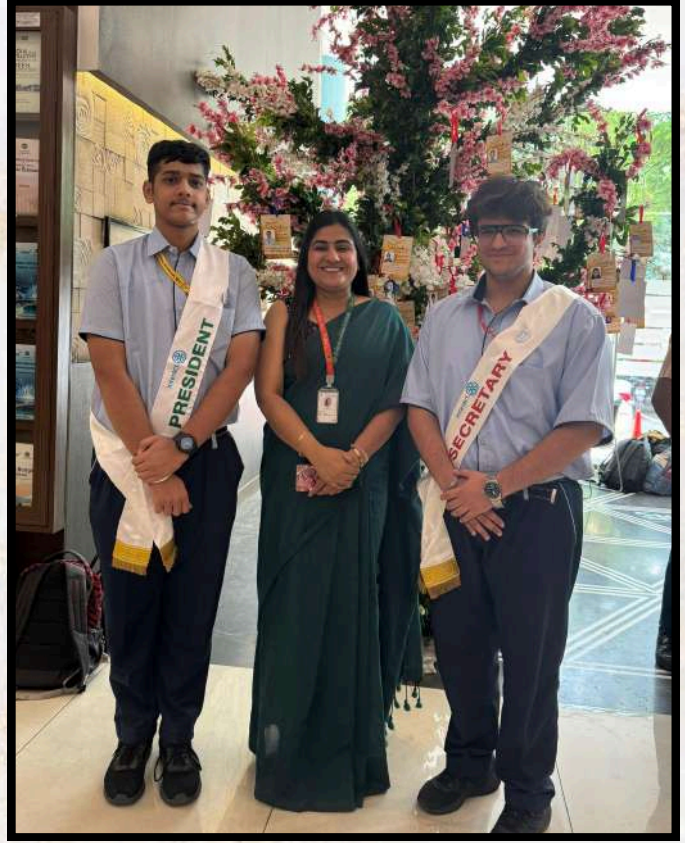
