Subject: Effective implementation of Delhi Lakhpati Bitiya Scheme (DLBS) – regarding nomination of Nodal Officer and furnishing of requisite details.

The undersigned is directed to invite attention to the Department of Women & Child Development (DWCD), GNCTD letter dated **14.08.2026** regarding effective implementation of the Delhi Lakhpati Bitiya Scheme (DLBS). It may be recalled that the Delhi Ladli Scheme has been renamed/upgraded as **Delhi Lakhpati Bitiya Scheme (DLBS)** w.e.f. **01.04.2026** with the objective of providing financial assistance to eligible girl children at various educational milestones, thereby promoting continuity in education, reducing dropout rate and ensuring long-term financial security.

The effective implementation of the Scheme requires active participation of all schools, as the schools serve as the primary interface between the Scheme and the eligible beneficiaries. The Nodal Officer nominated by each school is required to act as the single point of contact for dissemination of information relating to the Scheme among eligible students and parents, facilitation of registration and renewal applications, verification of student-related details/documents, coordination with the concerned DWCD District Office, coordination of operational issues relating to the Scheme and ensuring timely access of eligible girl students to the benefits available under the Scheme.

In this regard, necessary directions have already been issued by the Directorate of Education vide **Order No. F No. DOE-A44/671/2026/Plg/E-376332/843-849 dated 09.06.2026**. Further, a Joint Advisory signed by the Secretary (WCD) and Principal Secretary (Education) was also circulated among all Heads of Schools of Government Schools, Government Aided Schools and Government Recognized Private Schools vide **F. No. DE18-5(18)/Plg/DLBS/2026-27/E-392410/1321-1328 dated 29.07.2026**.

However, DWCD has brought to the notice of the Directorate that only a limited number of schools have furnished the details of their nominated Nodal Officers to the respective DWCD District Offices. Non-nomination of Nodal Officers on the DLBS Portal may adversely affect timely registration and renewal of eligible beneficiaries under the Scheme.

Accordingly, all **Heads of Schools of Government Schools, Government Aided Schools and Government Recognized Private Schools** are hereby directed to ensure nomination of a Nodal Officer for implementation of the Delhi Lakhpati Bitiya Scheme in their respective school, wherever not already done, and furnish the prescribed details of the nominated Nodal Officer to the concerned DWCD District Office as well as to the Planning Branch, Directorate of Education, on priority, whereas the same have not already been furnished. Further, all **DDEs (District/Zone)** are requested to ensure strict compliance with the aforesaid directions and closely monitor the status of nomination of Nodal Officers by all schools under their respective jurisdiction.

The matter may be accorded **TOP PRIORITY**, keeping in view the welfare of eligible girl children and the objective of ensuring timely and effective implementation of the Delhi Lakhpati Bitiya Scheme.
