We sincerely believe that your support will encourage greater participation from schools and help foster scientific thinking, innovation, and research among young students across Delhi.

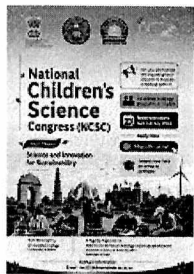

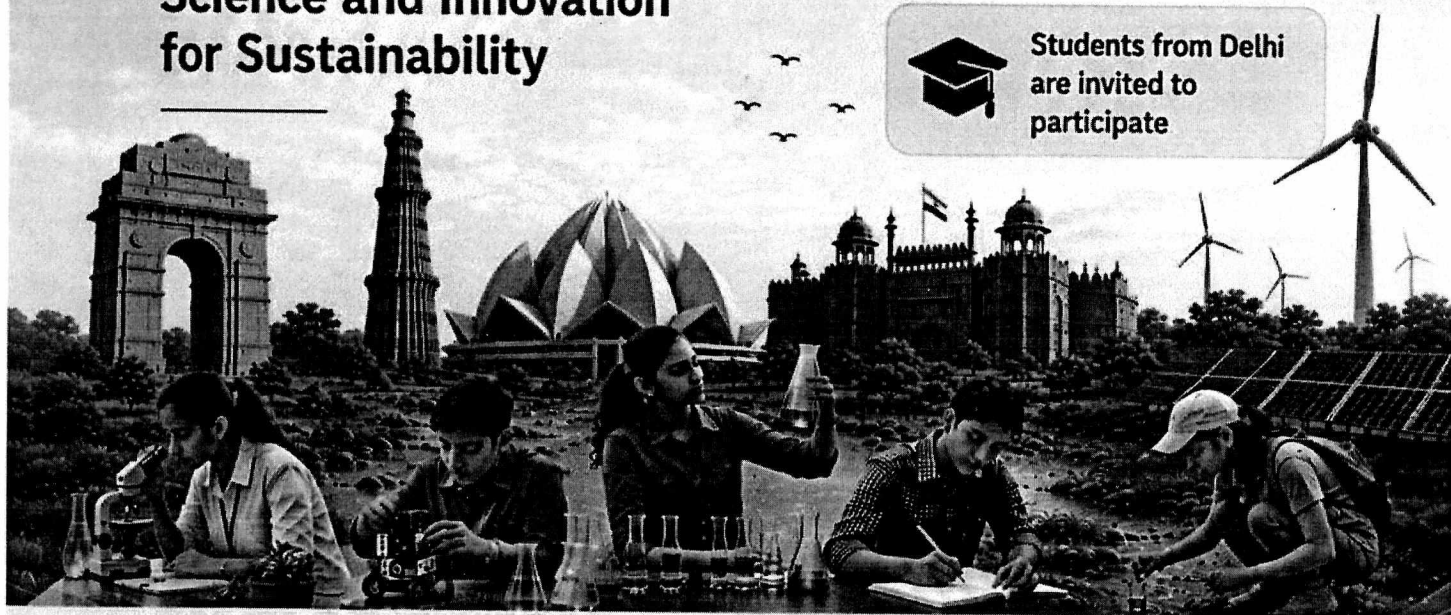
