CIRCULAR

Subject: Support for implementation of HPV Vaccination Campaign for eligible girl students (14–15 years) in NCT of Delhi.

Please find enclosed herewith D.O.No.15978 dated: 06.03.2026 received from Secretary Health and Family Welfare, regarding HPV Vaccination.

In this regard, all Heads of Government, Government Aided and Recognized Private Schools under Directorate of Education are hereby informed that the Health & Family Welfare Department, GNCTD has launched an HPV Vaccination Campaign to prevent Cervical Cancer among adolescent girls.

Under the campaign, one dose of HPV vaccine will be administered to all eligible girls in the age group of 14–15 years in NCT of Delhi over a period of three months. The vaccination will be conducted at designated Government Health Facilities by trained vaccination teams and recorded on the U-WIN Portal.

Since a majority of girls in this age group are school-going, schools are requested to extend full cooperation in successful implementation of the campaign.

Accordingly, all Heads of Schools are directed to undertake the following actions:

1. Nominate a Nodal Teacher (preferably TGT N. Sc.) for coordination of activities related to the HPV Vaccination Campaign.
2. Prepare a line list of all eligible girls aged 14–15 years studying in the school in the prescribed format. List of all eligible girl students as per given age category must be mailed to District Immunization Officers (DIOs) by 25th March, 2026. (attached herewith). **(list attached)**
3. Ensure that the School Nodal Teacher coordinates with the concerned District Immunization Officer (DIO) and School Health Scheme District Nodal Officer for mobilization of eligible students to the designated vaccination site as per the session plan.
4. Disseminate information regarding HPV vaccination among parents and students through school assemblies, WhatsApp groups and other appropriate communication channels.

5. Circulate and collect consent forms from parents/guardians of eligible girls and ensure that the signed consent forms are available during the vaccination session. Consent forms must be taken in hard copy and kept in safe custody by Heads of Schools.

All Heads of Government, Government Aided and Recognized Private Schools under Directorate of Education shall ensure timely compliance and extend full cooperation to the Health Department for the successful implementation of the HPV Vaccination Campaign and maintain proper record of students who shall be vaccinated.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.

Dear Sh. Sanjeerji ,

Cervical Cancer is a significant health problem in the country, which is also the only cancer preventable by a vaccine against Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). This HPV vaccination done at early age in the girls provides significant preventive protection against this Cervical Cancer.

Thus, as a commitment to encourage vaccination of girls in the country, the HPV Vaccination Campaign has been launched at National level as well as in all States / UTs on 28th February 2026. The campaign aims to provide one dose of HPV Vaccine to all eligible girls of age 14-15 years in NCT of Delhi, during the following period of 3 months. The vaccination will be conducted at Government Health Facilities by a trained Vaccination Team and will be recorded on the U-WIN Portal.

Under your dynamic leadership, the involvement of **Education Department** in the Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) has been instrumental in supplementing the achievements under the programme. Since, girls of the age 14-15 years are school going at this age juncture, Department of Education, GNCTD is envisaged to play a key role in successful conduction of this HPV Vaccination Campaign. In this regard, active support is sought from your department in the HPV Vaccination Campaign in the following ways:

- i. Depute a Nodal Officer in each School, each Zone and at State for coordination regarding the campaign.
- ii. All Nodal Officers at Schools to prepare Line List of all eligible girls in the age group of 14-15 years (as per attached Format).
- iii. All Nodal Officers to liaison with the respective District Immunization Officers (DIOs) and School Health Scheme District Nodal Officers (SHS-DNOs), for mobilization of eligible beneficiaries to the nearby health facility, as per the Session planning. Attached Consent Format to be circulated and compiled (from parents / guardians) for all eligible girls and physical copies of same to be provided during the planned session.
- iv. Instruct all Principal and Teachers to disseminate information and advocate HPV Vaccination at all possible platforms including PTMs, Prayers, WhatsApp Groups etc.

List of DIOs and SHS-DNOs is attached along with as Annexure-I and Annexure-II.

Looking forward to your kind support for successful conduction of HPV Vaccination Campaign in NCT of Delhi.
