❖ Open to learn


Read Daily: Choose books that interest you and make reading a daily habit.

Havelock

Havelock Island is a part of Ritchie's Archipelago, named after British General Sir Henry Havelock. However, in December 2018, it was renamed Swaraj Island as a tribute to Subhas Chandra Bose.

It belongs to the South Andaman administrative districts and comprises a chain of islands to the east of Great Andaman in the Andaman Islands.

The best and easiest way to reach Havelock is by the AC catamaran ferry, which only takes 90 minutes from Port Blair. Havelock can also be reached using the Government ferry, which takes up nearly 2.5 hours.

Neil Island

Neil Island aka Shaheed Dweep is an island in Ritchie's Archipelago lying 36 Km northeast from Port Blair. Neil Island can be reached by taking an early morning boat from Port Blair. This island has good connectivity with different cruises that are available from cities like Chennai and Kolkata.

The favorable month to visit Neil Island is between October and May and the best season to visit is winter and onset of summers.

Neil Island is best for sightseeing with exotic beaches like Lakshmanpur Beach, Bharatpur Beach, and Neil Kendra. One can also indulge in water activities like Scuba Diving, Swimming, and Cycling. Being a breeding place for schools of fish, it is a popular spot for Sportfishing.

Barren Island

Barren Island is located off the coast of Burma near the Andaman Islands. This island is located in the Andaman Sea and is the only active volcano in India. In order to reach Barren Island, there are two ways. One can take a sea plane from Port Blair or a ferry ride, which takes three rounds around the island.

In Barren Island, it is not allowed to stay at night, thus, one must take early morning rides to the island. Since Barren Island is an active volcano, thereby, there aren't many activities to be done other than sightseeing and photography.

Mayabunder Island

Mayabunder is a town and a [tehsil](#) in the northern part of [Middle Andaman Island](#), [Andaman Archipelago](#), [India](#). The name is also spelled **Maya Bunder** or **Maya Bandar**. As of 2001, the county had 23,912 inhabitants, of which 3182 were in the town. It was settled in the British colonial period by immigrants from Myanmar and ex-convicts from Mainland India. Administratively, Mayabunder is the headquarters of the North and Middle Andaman district, which is part of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands territory.

Mayabunder is located in North Andaman and provides beautiful island getaways or day trips. Mayabunder is a town in the northern part of Andaman Archipelago. Mayabunder Island is a time distance of about 10 hours from Port Blair; there are many direct buses from Port Blair to Mayabunder Island.

Parrot Island



Parrot Island is a small island located near Baratang and a Bird Watcher's paradise. The most suitable time to visit Parrot Island is during winter. One can take an STS bus, taxi or boat after reaching Baratang from Port Blair to reach this paradise of birds. Then from Baratang Jetty, one has to take a Dunghi boat ride; regular ferries are also available.

If you visit the island in the evening, you can easily spot various spots of exotic birds. Other adventurous things to be done in Parrot Island are Scuba Diving, jet skiing, and snorkeling.

Cellular Jail

The Cellular Jail is the most prominent landmark of Port Blair, or, for that matter the Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The first stop for any dignitary visiting the Islands is the Martyrs Memorial inside the Jail.

This three-storeyed prison, constructed by Britishers in 1906, is a pilgrimage destination for freedom fighters. This colossal edifice has mutely witnessed the most treacherous of inhumane atrocities borne by the convicts, who were mostly freedom fighters. Now dedicated to the nation as a National Memorial.
