The presence of the father of the nation Shri Mahatma Gandhiji's in the visitors gallery during the debate on the Rowlatt Act lend deep symbolic significance to this venue. This building had served as the Imperial Legislative Council (1912-1921) and subsequently Central Legislative Assembly (1921-1927).
