

**Rabindra Kala Sammaan (Juniors) 2021-22**

Dear Parents,

Rabindra kala Sammaan is the **Annual Rolling Trophy of DIS EDGE** awarded to the Outstanding Artist of the Year at junior (Class I-V) and senior level (class VI-IX).

The entries for the **Rabindra kala Sammaan** for session 2021-22 opens in July 2021. The screening will be done in three rounds:

- Round I: Class level competition out of which the top 10 percentile will qualify for round II
- Round II: Semifinals for the top 10 percentile selected children from round I.
- Round III: The finals will be judged by an external subject expert.

The details and judgment criteria for each round will be announced Fortnightly before the competition date.

Judgment Criteria Round - I

The entries will be judged on a) **idea**, b) **color scheme**, c) **neatness**, d) **aesthetic appeal**, e) **overall presentation and creativity**.
On a 10 Point scale for each of A to E.

Guidelines for Round - I

- Drawing/painting must be on A4/A3 size sheet.
- Make a border of 2cm broad. **Border is compulsory**. You can keep the paper ready with borders before the start of competition.
- If a child has not participated in the first round, he/she will not be eligible for the second round.
- Name of the student, class, section should be mentioned on right side top corner.
- Image should be clearly scanned and labeled and mailed to pallavisharma12.07@gmail.com with a cc to disedgecompetitions.gurjeet@gmail.com
- The competition will commence in the art and craft period of respective class of the **week 4, i.e., 19th to 23rd July**.
- Duration of competition is **1 Hour and 15 minutes for submission** are being provided for uploading the image and mailing it to the teacher.
- The entries will be subjected to norms/guidelines/considerations/criteria as listed above. ENSURE CHILD'S ORIGINAL WORK If the submissions do not match the regular class work level of the child, the entries may be disqualified.
